A special meeting of the Board of Education of the San Diego Unified School District, County of San Diego, California, was held at Eugene Brucker Education Center Auditorium, 4100 Normal Street, San Diego, California on April 12, 2011.

- Call to Order President Barrera called the meeting to order at 9:30 am with all members present except member Barnett
- Adopt Agenda Motion by member Beiser seconded by member Jackson to adopt the agenda was approved.

Sally Smith and David Page provided public testimony to the Board regarding Title 1 funding.
- Area Supt Area Superintendent Reorganization (Attachment A4) Information Only
Mike Price, Shirley Wilson, Susan Levy, Listy Gillingham, Brad Callahan, Zoneice Jones, Gerald Brown, Pat Washington, Angela Bass and Tony Burks provided public testimony to the Board regarding area superintendents.
Motion by member Jackson to keep the current area superintendent structure and the current number of area superintendents for next year, died for lack of a second. The Board and Superintendent clarified today's discussion at the special meeting is for clarity of staff direction.
- Education Funding Resolution Resolution in Support for Legislative Accountability for Education Funding (Attachment A5)
Motion by member Evans, seconded by member Jackson to adopt the Resolution in Support for Legislative Accountability for Education Funding. Amendment to the motion made by member Beiser, seconded by member Jackson to add that all references to education be modified to state, K-12 public education, was approved unanimously. President Barrera passed the gavel and moved, seconded by member Jackson, to remove the paragraph regarding Proposition 98, was approved unanimously. The resolution as twice amended to add references to K-12 public education and to delete the paragraph regarding Proposition 98, was approved unanimously.
